

Second-round loss takes Nick Chappell out of French Open Juniors

Even with a loss in the second round, it was still a successful debut for Indy's Nick Chappell in the French Open Junior tournament. Chappell, who came into the tournament with an combined ITF junior ranking of 26, won his first-round match in three sets over France's Antoine Escoffier, 6-2, 5-7, 6-3, before falling to 10th-seeded Mate Zsiga of Hungary, 6-2, 6-1. Chappell, a former Indiana state high school singles champion at North Central High School, also has a direct-acceptance into the Wimbledon junior tournament later this month. (6-1-10)
