

## Schneider defends IHSAA singles title; Park Tudor duo claims doubles championship

Bloomington South's Ronnie Schneider became the first player to win back-to-back boys' state singles titles since 1988 Saturday, defeating Park Tudor's Brendan Tannenbaum, 4-6, 6-1, 6-3 in the IHSAA singles & doubles finals at Park Tudor School. The junior, who also won the USTA National Championships in Kalamazoo last summer, finished with a 23-0 record. Center Grove's Luke Andersen finished in third following a win over Angola's Georg Albrecht in the consolation match. On the doubles side, Park Tudor's Sam Geier and Dan Rayl defeated the Floyd Central pair of Drew Hussung and Jarret Oldham, 6-3, 6-1 to win the doubles title. Plainfield's Caleb Knust and the Zionsville doubles team of John Sides and Jeff Yu also made it to the finals rounds, losing in Friday's quarterfinals.
