

Schneider takes singles, doubles at 'Zoo' Nationals

Bloomington's Ronnie Schneider won both the singles and doubles titles in the Boys' 16s at the USTA National Championships in Kalamazoo, Michigan. The second-seeded Schneider, the defending IHSAA boys' singles champion, defeated fourth-seeded Luca Corintelli, 5-7, 7-6, 6-2. On the doubles side, Schneider teamed with Yale Goldberg as the top seeds. Indy's Nick Chappell, who entered the Boys' 18s as the 30th seed, advanced to the round of 32 before losing to the 14th-seeded Spencer Newman, 7-5, 6-2.
